Board approved tree removal for \$750 by Arbor-Nomics. Tree was removed on February 25th. Old Azalea plants have been removed. Significant pruning was accomplished in other areas. Cottage Care

Board approved \$1200 for removal of old chimney cap, installation of new cap, chimney repair, soffit repair and gutter installation on either side of chimney. Work is warranted for 1 year and was completed on February 24th. Bids for interior wall repair near the fireplace and painting of exterior trim are in process. A new wildlife exclusion agreement and quarterly pest control maintenance agreement have been signed.

Arbor Day in Norcross

Several members attended the Arbor Day celebration hosted by the city of Norcross. Two trees were planted on Barton Street. Johnson Dean Forest was recognized as the first forest in Gwinnett County to become a part
